My Response to the Main Issues Report

Development Bid Reference - B0944 - Inchgarth Road

I believe that the land at Inchgarth Road should be included in the Local Development Plan for the following reasons: -

I strongly support the planning application ref. number 181224/PP regarding the Land at Inchgarth Road Cults. I am currently serving in the British Army in Northern Ireland and my grandparents live on one of the minor roads used as a rat run between between the North Deeside Road and Inchgarth Road. I am therefore a frequent visitor and user of these roads which are narrow country roads, totally unsuitable for the increasing volume of traffic and unsafe for pedestrians and cyclists. All three roads have poor junction visibility and are sub-standard roads recognised locally as a safety hazard because of the numbers of scrapes and accidents there. The problems accessing and exiting these roads impacts on the 2 main roads.

The site for this application is not usable by the general public and is frankly a mess. It is the ideal place for a new purpose built link road. The new road will vastly improve journeying between the North Deeside Road and Inchgarth Road and access to the railway line for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists. This provides a much safer route and will remove traffic from the three small roads currently used as well as side roads leading to them.

I like the design of the plan because it retains some open space and the housing is not too high for the area or overcrowded.
