

Summary of Likes:

There were a lot of things which participants liked about this area, for example:

Mix of old and new buildings; Union Square (new, modern, warm, clean - a nice environment with shops all under one roof / plenty to do / friendly / active); the Train and Bus Stations incorporated into Union Square; Train Station very well sign posted; old tram shed on Riverside Drive; boats in the Harbour.

Summary of Dislikes:

There were however things that participants didn't like, for example:

Union Square can be busy and noisy; empty sites in old fish processing area; smelly (especially at harbour / fish processing area); litter; lots of traffic and parked cars; Union Square is in the wrong location; Bus Station too small and busy; Train Station too exposed; Market Street; Riverside Drive.


Summary of Opportunities and Proposed Enhancements:

- Clean up Riverside
- Fill empty buildings (offices)
- More pedestrian friendly
- More environmentally friendly uses Traffic diverted from Market Street
- More trees, gardens & open space
- Pedestrian walkway from Union Square to harbour / ferry port
- Buildings for leisure rather than offices
- Clean up Riverside

- Gardens on the roofs of offices
- Bowling Alley
- Ban HGVs in the City Centre
- Public safety improved
- Better access to River Dee so people can visit and enjoy
- Shops built in Food Processing Area
- Gardens on the roofs of offices
