I wish to support the development bid re the land between Inchgarth Road and the North Deeside Road.

Living at [REDACTED], I am a frequent user of the roads between Inchgarth Road and the North Deeside Road: Pitfodels Station Road, Westerton Road and St. Devenick's Road. None of these roads are fit for purpose and all have safety issues as I'm sure the Council are aware. Pitfodels Station Road and Westerton Road have very poor sight lines at both ends and frequently cause hold-ups on the North Deeside Road. They are dangerous for pedestrians, cyclists and vehicular traffic. Pitfodels Station Road is particularly dangerous for pedestrians as only a small part of the road has a footpath which is very narrow. Also accessing the Deeside Way from the bridges on both roads is clearly a safety hazard, particularly for children and parents with buggies.

The development of a link road as described in this proposed development would provide a much safer route for all concerned and would remove traffic from the minor roads as well as from Deeview Road South and Ashfield Road. It would also provide the potential for new bus routes with public transport links between Inchgarth Road and the North Deeside Road, improving connectivity between different parts of the city. As well as leading to substantial improvements in the roads, this development benefits the community and the area by providing accessible open space and easier and safer access to the Deeside Way for everyone including the disabled.
