I write to object to the proposed development of Justice Hill Lane and Langstone Place as a twenty four hour economy, if this is indeed the plan. (Please see the freedom of information request made by the Bon Accord Residents Association). It is my opinion that, were this to go ahead, the amount of anti-social behaviour going on in my garden and Bon Accord Terrace Gardens will increase. This is an infringement of my human rights, as set out in the Aberdeen City website. I have lived at the above address since 2006 and have seen that local business and local residents can get along very well, but there have been times when this balance has been over stepped.

I further object to the EN03 roads pedestrianisation project as

this will lead to more late night traffic noise along the Hardgate and Bon Accord Terrace. ENO3 in combination with the 24 hour business project will only make these matters worse. There will be more lingering and loitering in the area and therefore more anti-social behaviour.
