Hello Brian

I am writing in respect of Further Information Request 05 concerning OP18 Craibstone North and Walton Farm.

I can confirm that the text in Appendix 2 identifying this site for employment, higher education, research is not an error.

It should be noted that the site is not zoned as 'housing land release'. It is identified under Policy LR1 Land Release Policy. This policy can apply to both housing sites and employment sites or sites which have a mixture of both uses. Policy LR1 explains that the amount and types of development applicable to sites and their phasing is shown in Tables 3 to 8 of the Proposed Plan from Page 11 onwards. Table 4 shows the uses considered appropriate to OP18 together with phasing for the site. This is consistent with the site description for OP18 in Appendix 2.

Policy LR1 generally applies to the greenfield allocations which extend beyond 2026 and/or to greenfield sites which have a mixture of allocated uses (i.e. specific housing and employment allocations).

I trust this provides some clarification, but if you need any further details then please get in touch.
