What would you like to say about the issue?

I am very concerned about the councils' proposal to allow the Milltimber School site to be sold for MORE housing development. The Oldfold farm site is to have a very large number of new houses which will no doubt attract many families to the area and increase traffic considerably.

Milltimber already is home to a large proportion of families, and the Milltimber Primary playing field is the only green space for recreation at the lower end of Milltimber. Many sporting activities are held there in addition to being used as a play area. The site would be better used by developing it into a play park and sports field.

There area also many mature and beautiful trees around the park which should be protected.

The residents of Bingill Park including myself would have our outlook obliterated, possibly to the detriment of house values.

Access to the site would be from Binghill Crescent, not a wide street and already a very busy access road to the roads beyond. The entrance to the site would be no doubt just after 2 sharp bends which already are hazardous.

Monearn Gardens at the other end of the site is a narrow residential street highly unsuitable for increased traffic also.

PLEASE leave the field for recreational use of Milltimber residents!

What change would you like to see made?

Once Milltimber School is demolished, develop the land and field into a childrens play park and a sports field. Save the mature trees that border the field.
