AS ONE OF THE PEOPLE LIVING IN THE HOUSES BORDERING, THE NEW DEVELOPMENT I FREQUENTLY SEE DEER AND FOXES IN THE WREA OF THE PROPOSED SITE AND I FEAR THESE WOULD DISAPPEAR FROM THE AREA.

THERE ARE CONCERNS ABOUT BUILDING SO CLOSE TO A TRAIN LINE AND SINCE THE NEW HOUSES ARE ALL AIMED AT FAMILIES THEREARE GOING TO BE. CHILDREN EVERYWHERE. I THINK IT IS TOTALLY IRRESPONSIBLE TO PUT SUCH A HIGH RISK INTO THE LIVES OF CHILDREN JUST SO A BUILDING COMPANY CAN MAKE LOADS OF MONEY. THE ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC IS ALSO A MAJOR CONCERN. THE MAND OUT ROADS IN THAT AREA ARE NOT DESIGNED TO TAKE THAT VOLUME OF TRAFFIC.

I WOULD LIKE TO SEE A STOP PUT ON THIS AND ANY OTHER PROPOSAL TO BUILD NEW HOUSES IN COVE. WE SIMPLY DO NOT HAVE THE ROOM, THE ROTADS OR THE SERVICES REQUIRED BY ALL THESE NEW DEVELOPMENTS.
