What is Aberdeen Care & Repair?

We are a voluntary organisation providing free advice and technical assistance on repairs, improvements and adaptations in the home.

We are funded by Aberdeen City Council and are managed by Castlehill Housing Association.

Who is eligible?

Owner-occupiers and tenants of private landlords living in Aberdeen who are older, disabled or suffering from long-term illness. Tenants of social landlords can also receive assistance for repairs that are not covered by their tenancy agreement.

What about the cost?

Our advice service is **FREE**. Grants may be available from Aberdeen City Council and other agencies for the work. Fees may apply.

How can we assist?

Many homes are in need of repair or improvement **such as:**

- Repairing / Replacing windows and doors
- Rewiring
- Repair to gutters and down pipes

- Roof Repairs
- Upgrading heating facilities
- Draught-proofing
- Adaptations to the bathroom to suit individual's needs
- Minor Aids / Adaptations

We can assist by:

- Helping clients to obtain affordable warmth in their homes by ensuring they have efficient and economical heating systems
- Carrying out a home visit to assess the extent of work required
- Meeting with family members to discuss options
- Obtaining quotations from reputable contractors
- Assisting with paperwork
- Helping to arrange finance for the work, including charitable funding, if appropriate
- Offering a loan for the improvement works, if eligible
- Applying for appropriate benefits / or referring on to an appropriate organisation
- Ensuring that works are completed to an acceptable standard

Who will do the work?

We will obtain quotations from qualified and reliable contractors. If necessary we will also arrange for suitable consultants to provide plans and professional assistance.

The service has a Trusted Traders list comprising of local companies who can carry out the work.

Will the work be checked?

We will help ensure that the work is completed to an acceptable standard.

Small Repairs / Handyman Service

If you have a small repair or small task around the house that needs to be done and you don't know where to turn - let us help!

We employ tradesmen who can assist with minor work **such as:**
