## What would you like to say about the issue?

Gladman supports the Council's vision to provide for an increased population in Aberdeen City in order to achieve sustainable economic growth. However, the LDP housing strategy in it's current form fails to provide a generous and flexible housing land supply to address in the short term the historic under delivery of housing in the city.
Furthermore, the LDP does not include a mechanism to ensure additional housing sites are brought forward when a shortfall in the 5-year housing land supply arises. Scottish Planning Policy requires local authorities to maintain an effective 5-year housing land supply at all times.

## What change would you like to see made?

The Council should seek to allocate a wider range of sites in terms of scale and location to ensure the housing land supply has greater flexibility and sites are genuinely effective rather than relying on existing allocations which have historically failed to deliver.
The LDP should include a policy for assessing housing proposals on unallocated land when faced with a shortfall in the 5-year housing land supply.
