**What would you like to say about the issue?**

I am deeply concerned and saddened by the remorseless destruction of the beautiful countryside around our city. What has become of the important requirement for green belt?

I cannot see that the vast numbers of houses being built will in any way help any possible housing shortage. They are not "affordable" housing for those who cannot buy, but almost all are classed as executive houses. They sprout up like mushrooms wherever a field can be purchased. For example, Stewart Milne is to build 3,000 houses at Countesswells, an area already inadequately served by roads, let alone the rest of the essential infrastructure!

**What change would you like to see made?**

A cessation of all building until proper evaluation of requirements has been made. Where are all the prospective residents coming from, and what are they coming to, and for? Aberdeen is no longer a boom city. I understand that building has been halted on the South Seaside Road, at Blair, because insufficient buyers have been found.

It may be significant that since I came to live in this area, two primary schools have closed, and also 2 post offices. The S. Seaside Road is extremely busy and one shudders to envisage the chaos if several hundred more cars, at least, are released upon it's road.
