## The transport situation in this ward.

Boundary with Anderson Drive naturally has problems to volume of traffic.

Rat Runs-

Broomhill Road as a 30 mph. road speed cases a number of sat navigation redirections by way of Broomhill Rd onward the Great Southern Road avoiding the Bridge of Dee. Unfortunately arctic lorries become a serious hazard to the road width plus a primary school immediately after turning off South Anderson Drive.

The bus service is the bend type busses thus a bus and five or so arctic size lorries present a problem as the bus stops to collect or deliver passengers the tail back also increases.

Naturally this also makes the use of Gray Street a prime choice to short cut the Broomhill Road on ward to Holburn Street which has serious parking for its length again hazardous for inhabitants wanting to cross the street for say bus stop.

Children from the catchment area plus parents walking them to school are at risk in the opening and closing times.

All feeder street are used for all day parking due to free parking, the bus service takes people to Union Street and beyond.

Also occurs around Ashly Road School were yellow lines are treated as park and drop children, so even park on the corners of the entry roads Ashley Gardens is a 30 mph road the parents and others to avoid the lights at Ashley Road - Union Grove Traffic lights. This also is a problem in Ashley Lane as cars rat run.

All the feeder road are so badly rutted due to over use by non residents to avoid traffic lights.

Furthermore red light jumping blatantly at each light change.

Allenvale area is another park and ride type situation thus free flow is non existent in the 7AM till 7PM, This also causes problems when the grave yards are in use for a funeral.

Riverside Drive is a major artery, why cant to Old Bridge of Dee be widen by removal of pavements. As the shopping development at the Bridge of Dee provide a walk way in a tube form that walking public get a dry crossing the lorries wing mirror situation is solved partly.

Necessary is the dulling of Anderson Drive our fore father left this legacy form the thirties. The land is there why are you waiting.

Dee to Don as the Parkway is also ready for the same treatment.

Bus service is a joke on Aberdeen City First and Stage Coach one has to get the fare structure sorted out if the elderly bus pass can be used on any company in Scotland surly the two Unit are part of the link produce a travel card inter changeable to the cost base computer.

The sport village is suffering due to cost of children fare structure especially when A - B bus pass is not interchangeable.

Most of the area has owner occupiers housing older stock with a few new developments. This has mostly problems caused with the wealth of the owner occupiers multi car ownership street friction. Large a mount of tenement type property - due to the garden size typical example is eight lock ups and still a garden. Since the tenant rule have bur disappeared the gardens are jungles surly the law can be changed to enforce the gardens are mad as free standing parking this were existing give twelve places.

Miss use of crossing pavement and boundary wall on Union Grove is being allowed this must stop after all children walk to school safely without supervision, now a danger cased by inconsiderate people to lazy to walk from the lanes to their house flats.

Business we have a few in former banks and doctor practices orphanage shop type ares without parking.

Where buildings are converted the staff use the free street areas thus friction as tenements at night replaced by the offices in the day time. Furthermore is the local shops gain customers for food. Keeping the local small shop viable along with the schools around the area. One could say thriving.

New developments are being built with under ground parking, eg Union Grove at the Holburn Junction End.

The redevelopment of the Duthie Park is an added attraction to the areas open spaces.

Cycle path ways we have a number of lanes that are parallel with Queens Road Union Grove that could be made into cycle tracks this takes in schools like Albyn St peters Ashley Road Harlaw Academy eight percent of Grammar School St Margaret's Hamilton school. This would be highly safe flagged are the crossing St Swithin Street Albyn Grove Forrest Avenue. May be an American train crossing with flashing lights and bells.

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

#### The Natural Environment

Nellfield and Alenvale Cemeteries – Large areas where birds etc left largely undisturbed.

The Woodies – Strengths: a large unbuilt open area

Problems/Threats: only grass and large trees. Little biodiversity. Old garages. Possible Improvements: Places for wildlife to take hold, bird boxes, flowering

flowers and bushes.

Street trees - Strengths: Variety of species both mature and newly planted.

Problems/Threats: Old trees, Council not removing leaves in Autumn.

Drainage - Problems/Threats:Drainage flooding at Rendezvous roundabout and Crathie

Gardens.

Possible Improvements: Council to regularly clear street gulleys which appear to

be filling up with debris.

Underground Streams - Cellars flooding on North side of Cromwell Road, also at Brighton Place.

#### Housing, Business and Local Facilities

Residential areas are mainly residential

Strengths - Very little degraded or derelict land

Weaknesses - Lack of Indoor Community facilities.

Lack of Outdoor community facilities – Ruthrieston Sports Centre- facilities are limited and it is no longer open except from booking. Entrance gates and fence in poor state of repair, adding to the impression that the facility is closed. No information at gate to give info on who to contact if you want to use the facilities.

#### **Transport and Accessibility**

Need a park and ride for the north of the City to Garthdee University Campus.

Imitate other cities such as Vienna where wide pavements are divided into cycle path and pedestrian path.

Ruthrieston Centre (Pitsruan) – Keep and make more use of the facilities plus advertise to local community.

Cycle routes – lack of cycle routes/infrastructure to/from centres of work. Improvements to this Infrastructure could encourage people to cycle from within Aberdeen to work rather than drive.

Congestion - Volumes of Commuter and Commercial traffic using residential streets as a shortcut to avoid main roads such as Anderson Drive.

Bus services – buses from the centre and edges of Ashley and Broomhill wards to Union Street/shops etc is very expensive. If prices were more reasonable less people would drive into centre.

Bus services. First Bus and Stagecoach services are not interchangeable. All day ticket from one company cannot be used on other operator.

#### Architecture, Urban Design and the Historic Environment

Strengths: Granite Buildings – Granite buildings of architectural interest thoughout the area. Places such as Ferryhill Library should be conserved.


Weaknesses: Conservation area is being eroded. eg buildings being permitted in gardens at the back of Great Western Road.

Old houses being demolished and replaced by a different style (usually flats)

Preserve the large granite school buildings Broomhill School and Ashley Road School.

Miscellaneous – Make an open recreational square at Marshal College, making use of Architecture of Marishal College, Provest Skene's House etc Preserve Ruthrieston Sports Centre and promote its use.
