

CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982

CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO SEX SHOP LICENCES

1. The hours of opening will be restricted from 10am to 9pm daily.
2. No persons under the age of 18 years shall be admitted to the premises or employed in the business of the establishment.
3. No display, advertisement, signage or other matter shall be exhibited so as to be visible from the outside the premises, except:

A notice bearing
 - The inscription "sex shop"
 - The name, style or title to be approved by the Council
 - The hours of opening.
4. The licence holder shall retain control over all portions of the premises and shall not let out or part with possession of any part of the premises during the currency of the licence.
5. Any fire officer, police constable or authorised officer of the Council shall be permitted free access to the whole of the premises at any time and all reasonable directions and requirement of such officers or of the Council must be complied with.
6. The licence or a copy thereof shall be exhibited on the premises and shall be available for inspection at all times.
7. The external doors shall be fitted with an effective self-closing device and remain closed at all times other than when a person is passing through.
8. The licence holder shall maintain good order in the premises and shall ensure that all music is controlled to the satisfaction of the Council to ensure no nuisance is caused to neighbouring occupiers.
9. All windows to have frosted or reflective glass.
