There has been engagement and consultation with employees and their trade unions continuously and at all points, as well as with partner organisations to get views and input and employees have the opportunity to raise concerns. details of future engagement points are detailed in Appendices 3 and 4 of the associated report.

Throughout the process there has been close working with People and Organisational Development, and there will be an offer of wellbeing services to employees to guide them through the change process
