## **Local Place Plan Preparer Checklist**

## Introduction

Local Place Plans enable communities to set out their vision and aims for the future of their place. As set out by Scottish Government, Local Place Plans can be prepared and submitted by any Community Council or qualifying Community Controlled Body.

Community Councils are automatically enabled by Scottish Government to prepare Local Place Plans and therefore do not need to complete this Preparer Checklist.

## **Qualifying criteria**

This Preparer Checklist sets out the criteria that a Community Controlled Body must fulfil in order to meet the Scottish Government's requirements for preparing and submitting a Local Place Plan.

If an organisation wishing to prepare and submit a Local Place Plan cannot answer 'Yes' to either Question 1 or 2 below, they may wish to consider becoming a community-controlled body\* or working with an existing Community Body, e.g. their local Community Council.
